#### **School Meals**

Funded school meals are available for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. This initiative from the DfE has the purpose of aiding child development, supporting academic performance and improving levels of healthy eating.

#### Do I need to apply for this?


If you are on a low income, we highly recommend that you make a free school meals application as it will allow the school to unlock additional funding for your child, which will go towards supporting their development. Every child eligible for free school meals (because they are from a family on a lower income) can unlock up to £1,455 extra funding for school, which must be spent on supporting their development.

So, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and will automatically get a free meal, please do still make an application. Otherwise, we will not know that your child is eligible for additional funding.


